Formally *Economic Development News*, this new section will attempt to report on a broader scope of issues related to economic opportunity and growth.

Economic Development Commission Update

The EDC meets on the second Wednesday each month at 6:00 PM. The meetings are open to the public and activity can be followed through meeting minutes posted on the Village website.

Currently the Commission is working on several key projects including 7th Street streetscaping, the Metra station expansion, a TIF redevelopment project on the corner of Sheridan Road and 7th Street in the area known as the “Triangle” and the realization of the original master development plan for the marina.

While these projects take significant time to bring to fruition, progress is being made by way of achieving a series of important milestones. A new application for funding was recently submitted to the state for construction costs for the streetscape, Metra has indicated that construction could begin this summer on the expanded parking lot and warming shelter, a developer has submitted a proposal for the triangle and the state has been open to discussing additional development around the marina. The EDC is committed to continuing to work hard on these initiatives, in an effort to improve the economic prosperity of our community.

It has been a cold and rainy spring, but flowers are blooming again. Thank you to EDC Members Kurt Melander and Carl Simmons for coordinating with the local Girl Scouts for the planting of the flower pots along Sheridan Road and 7th Street. This is only one of the several ways that Kurt and Carl work to beautify the community and their efforts are very much appreciated.

Did you know that there are many things for Winthrop Harbor residents to do at North Point Marina? There are grills on the docks just outside each bath house that are open to the public on a first come, first served basis, beach side fire rings are available, but must be reserved at the Marina office and there is a sand volleyball court. The public beach on the north side of the Marina has plenty of parking and a picnic area in Harvey Park. Don't forget the numerous bike and walking paths, with an abundance of wild life, throughout the area.

If you are more adventurous there are plenty of opportunities for water sports, from the only free public boat launch on Lake Michigan to the handicap accessible fishing pier. There are sailing lessons offered by the Winthrop Harbor Yacht Club and even a world class salmon fishing derby planned for **August 23rd**.

North Point Marina, the Winthrop Harbor Yacht Club and the Winthrop Harbor Chamber of Commerce will be hosting **National Marina Day - Venetian Festival 2008** on **Saturday, August 9th** from Noon until 11:00 pm. Activities include arts & crafts vendors, food booths, live music, children's activities, Venetian parade of boats and topped off by a fireworks display. Admission and parking are free.

Also, on **Saturday, August 30th**, North Point Marina, Skipper Bud's and the Tropics Restaurant will be hosting the annual **End of Summer Celebration**.
